# The Baronial Address

God Fortsättning!

As we set pen to paper to write our last Jultide letter, our foremost hope is that all our Starkhafn Skuldalið and their loved ones are well sheltered and in good health. Many of you have heard us use the term Skuldalið over the past few years and provide the translation of the word as "family." This is an oversimplification of a very meaningful word. At this time of Midwinter, which inevitably brings a time of deep reflection and the recognition of the



power of the flame to ward off the darkness, we'd like to share what it means to us. The first part of the word, skulda(r), translates as debt or something owed. The second part, lið (related to the word hjún) can be defined as members of a household. Modern Icelandic defines the word as "team." A household of the Viking-age would include all of the extended family who shared their homestead. Even long before the Hávamál was written down, the ideal of hospitality was extolled as a virtue.

Hávamál – stanza 3

Elds er þörf þeims inn er kominn

ok á kné kalinn.

Matar ok váða er manni þörf,

þeim er hefr um fjall farit.

He hath need of fire, who now is come,

numbed with cold to the knee;

food and clothing the wanderer craves

who has fared o'er the rimy fell.

Sharing one's hearth and hospitality can be even more vital at this time of year. Because Winter can be brutal and unforgiving, one's household might also include guests who may have fallen on hard times or are unable to return home due to harsh weather or distance. In essence, creating a Skuldalid, a household of people who depend on each other for survival.

We consider Starkhafn as our Skuldalid, the community to which we owe a debt of hospitality and support. Most might define a debt as something negative, but for us not only is this debt a positive, it is an honour to be indebted, to share our hospitality with the amazing group of people who have chosen to support each other.

While we are much relieved to finally reach the close of this most vexing and difficult year, we feel blessed to have been witness to the giving spirit and caring legacy of this Skuldalid.

This past year has presented trials/adversities of varying degrees for us all. The inability to find our normal respite from the day-to-day hurdles/difficulties has only been compounded by the lack of in person events.
