

Dragon Cake History

The SCA has a long history of telling stories, from the 'No Sh*t there I was,' to the oral histories of famous battles, famous or infamous people, and so on. There is also a tradition that if something is done twice, it is a tradition, and if repeated three or more times, the origin is lost in the mists of time. So it is with our Dragon Cake.

I spoke to Baron Starkhafn, our first baron, Keradwc an Cai. The tradition has been going on so long, he had a hard time remembering every detail, other than it was about when we became a barony. He said that his mom made the first cake, and that the second one was a green rice crispy monstrosity. This could possibly have been the first one to be slain, but he wasn't sure. As to how the slaying of the dragon started, he thinks it was one of those, 'sounds like a good idea,' sort of things. At any rate, the cake and the dispatching has been going on for a long, long time.

Once upon a time, we bragged that Starkhafn was the gateway of kingdoms, and was the site of Estrella War councils between (aid and Atenveldt. This was years before Artemisia came into being and became a signatory to the council.
