### **New Caid Armored Combat Marshalling Guideline**

Greetings unto the populace of Caid from your New Earl Marshal. I look forward to seeing you as we enter into our 2023 Tournament season.

One of my goals is to help restore fighter trust. Both with each other and the populace.

In an effort to increase and normalize honest and open discussions between the fighters I am instituting the following policy for Armored Combat, effective at Consort's Champion and continuing through 2023.

At the end of each fight the Marshal will ask the fighters to separate and stand to the side. The Marshals will meet in the middle of the Eric and discuss the fight to see if there were any questionable blows. The fighters will be brought to the center of the Eric with the marshals and asked if there were any blows in question and are you satisfied with the fight. If there were questionable blows, the marshals will facilitate a discussion to determine the following.

- 1. In the opinion of the fighter who threw the blow. Was the blow an effective and telling blow. Meaning throwing with appropriate orientation, not impeded and landed with sufficient force.
- 2. The Marshals agree that the blow landed cleanly and with good orientation that it should have been a telling blow.
- 3. Based on the discussion would the fighters wish to refight the fight or let the outcome stand.

Note: There needs to be a balance between providing input and not interfering with the natural flow of the fight.

If there are clear any obvious concerns about the acknowledgment of blows that are a clear violation of the Rules of the Lists or the Conventions of Combat. The Marshal should stop the fight in progress to express their concerns. The fighters may be encouraged to perform a quick re-calibration prior to the fight continuing.

In the finals, usually a best of three.

We will have a strategic pause between fights to give the fighters a chance to catch their breaths, re-focus, and work through the process as previously described.

I am not suggesting determinate marshaling. I am asking that all fighters have trust in each other and help us normalize discussion and calibration across the Kingdom.

I am in discussions with the Crown and members of the Chivalry to put in place a policy, if the fighters are unable to resolve the issues and additional intervention is needed.

It is my sincerest hope that the additional policy will not be necessary and through open and honest discussions we can restore trust in each other and live up to the conventions of combat that our Society was founded on.

### MARSHALING GUIDANCE AND SOP FOR INTERACTIONS WITH HEAVY COMBAT FIGHTERS

### **Situation/Background Information:**

There have been many fighters on the field who, despite the agreements of fighting chivalrously, are not doing so. They refuse to take what others observe to be justified blows.

In the past those who have been confronted after the fight have sometimes agreed that they didn't fight "clean", and will "do better" or simply, "sorry." Most are willing to let bygones be bygones and will be more chivalrous, self-correct and do better next time. Others use these as excuses, as demonstrated in later fights, as the same behaviors are repeated without any changes. This SOP and guidance is for the fighters who are unable to self-correct.

This has brought about complaints and notice from the populace. The introduction of this guide is meant as a background to the procedure/SOP that will set in place a method to curtail issues with combatants the instant it happens, on the field and before one combatant is declared victorious over the other. This is a challenging task but necessary if we are going to balance martial competition and the Arthurian dream of the SCA.

Localized scenario-based training to include knights and Marshals is highly encouraged. This will help those monitoring combat be prepared to react to situations more quickly. Assigning a scribe for the day could assist in quick collection of documentation should an incident occur.

Note that from the Marshals handbook "Effectiveness of a blow may not be judged by the opposing combatant, the marshal on the field, or other observers." However, this is the important caveat to the above statement: "Judging the effects of blows is left to the honor of the combatant being struck by the weapon, unless he or she relinquishes this responsibility, with the exception of clear violations of the Rules of the Lists or the Conventions of Combat."

### **PURPOSE:**

To facilitate immediate solutions and resolution if issues arise between combatants during a tournament. Combatants must communicate clearly, calmly and concisely to each other as to the effectiveness of their blows.

The Marshal(s) on the field are the first line of interaction if the fighters are not communicating. Every effort shall be given to facilitate the communication and discussion between fighters. The marshals are an active part of the communication, as per the Marshals handbook - "Information unavailable to the combatant being struck may be supplied by the opposing combatant or the marshal, including blade orientation upon impact, apparent force transmitted, or apparent location and angle of the blow's impact based upon the observer's angle of observation."

If the Marshal(s) is unable to resolve the issue on the field the Marshal in Charge (MIC) shall immediately be notified of the situation. Any Knight witnessing the events should come to the field to assist the MIC.

### **ACTION:**

- I. When any knight sees effective blows with sufficient force being ignored or not being acknowledged, and they are happening too frequently or a clear violation of the Rules of the list or the Conventions of Combat, it is their duty to raise a hand, call "hold" and step onto the field at that moment.
- II. The knight will then approach the fighters and the marshal. Other knights who feel the same should join without delay. The MIC should be notified and brought to the field.
- III. The conversation should include telling the fighter(s) in question what is being seen and give the combatants the opportunity to respond, explain, acknowledge, or accept what has been witnessed.
- IV. Rank, skill, or peerage does not exclude any combatant from this process.
- V. If they continue to be unable/unwilling to acknowledge blows that are effective and delivered with sufficient force, the process may take place again. No more than two (2) warnings will be allowed.
- VI. If the issue continues to a third hold in the combat the Marshals and Knight(s) shall expedite the decision to remove the fighter from the tournament to the Marshal in Charge and present Royal(s)
- VII. Issues should be communicated and settled before the combatants leave the field. If the outcome of the fight will not be changed or a significant delay will occur the discussion should be moved off the field to be resolved. A Knight should remain present on the field if necessary.

If a fighter is removed from combat or forced to cede the fight this event shall result in adverse event report being written. The report will include the following:

A description of the event and the fighter's account of the event. Witness statements. Fighter(s) impacted area. (Physical description) The combatant(s) gear, armor or other items that may need to be addressed. The number of times the combat was stopped is to be included.

This also allows for tangible data to be collected, trends tracked, and recorded. This report shall be sent to the Earl Marshal and the Chivalry and currently seated Royals. A report should also be written if a fighter is having repeated issues that do not result in their removal or cede a fight. The report will be available to the fighter in questions for their awareness and self-correction. This also allows for tangible data to be collected, trends tracked, and recorded.

### **CONCLUSION:**

The Knights should be prepared at any time to negate unchivalrous conduct on the field. This means being vigilant, balanced, and analytical as appropriate. Training and understanding of the "who, what, when, why, and where" will be vital to quick and strong conflict resolution. Spectators are always encouraged to approach members of the Chivalry to ask questions regarding combat that is occurring on the field but should be aware that they may be focused on the current fighting. Remember, these discussions can be difficult if both parties did not witness the combat. Remember, the goal is to **NOT** have to enact determinate marshaling.
